## **ORDINANCE #40**

TITLE: An Ordinance Readopting the Existing Benton County Code of Ordinances and/or Repealing Certain Portions Therein.

Be it Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Benton County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. <u>Purpose</u>. Iowa Code Section 331.302, Subsection 9, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its Code of Ordinances. This Ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect in Benton County, Iowa, and/or repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Benton County, Iowa.
