The Benton County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with Supervisors Seeman and Bierschenk present, Primmer called in. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. at the conference room at the Benton County Service Center. Roy Schulz and Wayne Shannon, members of the Pioneer Cemetery Commission came to update the Board on their budgeted items and projects they have been working on. They have been working on signs and surveying, and will also be getting signs on their vehicles to distinguish who they are and also photo IDs. The commission is also hoping to set up a monument to put the names and grave marker in Stringtown Cemetery.
