WULFENIA BULLII

Kittentails have dense spikes of small yellow flowers 2-6 inches long that begin blooming at the bottom of the spike and work their way up. They live in the driest parts of the prairie. When possible the plants will form a colony. Found only in the Midwest, they have become so rare that they are listed on the Upper Midwest threatened species list.
